PROEGLER SELECTED TO BE WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP TRUSTEE

Dublin, OH, January 12, 2004- Kurt Proegler has been selected to serve as Trustee for Washington Township. Proegler was appointed by Board Chair Denise King and Gene Bostic to fill the vacancy created by Michael Keenan, who was elected to Dublin City Council this past November. He will begin serving as soon as he takes the oath of office and posts bond, which is anticipated to occur within the next few days.

Proegler, a resident of the township since 1977, served on the Washington Township Board from 1990-1999. He has also served as the assistant zoning inspector and consultant to the Township on a long term financial planning project in 2000. His involvement in communities within and neighboring the Township have included serving as chairman for the Hilliard School District bond issue in 1991, chairman of the Washington Township-Dublin Merger Study Group and Commission, and as a founding trustee of the Heritage Rails to Trails Coalition.
